## Gallery Artists: Recent Work

Friday, November 8, 2008, Anya Tish Gallery opens a group show, Gallery Artists: Recent Work. Opening Reception for the artists will take place Saturday, November 8. The exhibition will be on view until December 24, 2008 at 4411 Montrose, Houston, TX 77006. Gallery hours are Wednesday through Saturday, 12 to 6.

The exhibit will feature a variety of new, exciting work from ten international, regional and local artists, offering a chance to see the latest work by ten selected artists represented by the Anya Tish Gallery. The integration of the show's diverse media brings to light visual relationships amongst the artwork, as well as new directions by some of this area's most dynamic artists.

Orna Fienstein, a master printmaker, reveals for the first time, monoprints printed on Plexiglass, using several layers of ink. William Cannings will be presenting a new sculpture titled *Luna*, as he continues to display the sensual results of steel inflated by compressed air. Cannings' work exhibits properties that seemingly contradict the physical possibilities of the materials being used.

Other works to be shown include the vibrant, highly textured, multi-layered "drip paintings" by Charlotte Smith, as well as a thirteen foot installation comprised of hundreds of handkerchiefs by Elana Lopez-Poirot, who continues to explore ideas of family relationships and persistent memories. In another installation John Knott offers whimsical sculptures made of fiberglass, plastic and Mylar, molded from a vintage upright Eureka vacuum. Both Garland Fielder's and Jozsef Bullas' work play with perception and space. Fielder's black and white paintings seem to contort geometric shapes, while Bullas' blurred grids of color pulsate with energy and tension.

Other artists being included are Pawl Dutkiewicz, Leszek Lewandowski, and Maxim Wakultschik.
